FF OPEN PRESS

FF Open Press is a platform for open access books from the University of Zagreb Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, active since 2019. The Faculty publishes around 30 book titles a year (mostly as a part of its publishing service FF Press production, but other organizational units such as Faculty departments and offices are also active). Currently, there are 107 published titles on the platform. FF Open Press publishes monographs, edited volumes, conference proceedings and textbooks on various topics in social sciences and humanities. Through the FF Open Press, all new releases are being made available in open access. Gradually, older editions, previously only available in print, will also be made available as open access e-books. All scholarly editions published by the Faculty undergo an independent peer review process, supervised and organised by the Publishing Council.

OMP

OMP - Open Monograph Press is an open source software platform for managing and publishing scholarly books. It can be used for managing the editorial workflow required to see monographs, edited volumes and, scholarly editions through internal and external review, editing, cataloguing, production, and publication. OMP can operate, as well, as a press website with catalog, distribution, and sales capacities.

LIBRARIAN'S ROLE

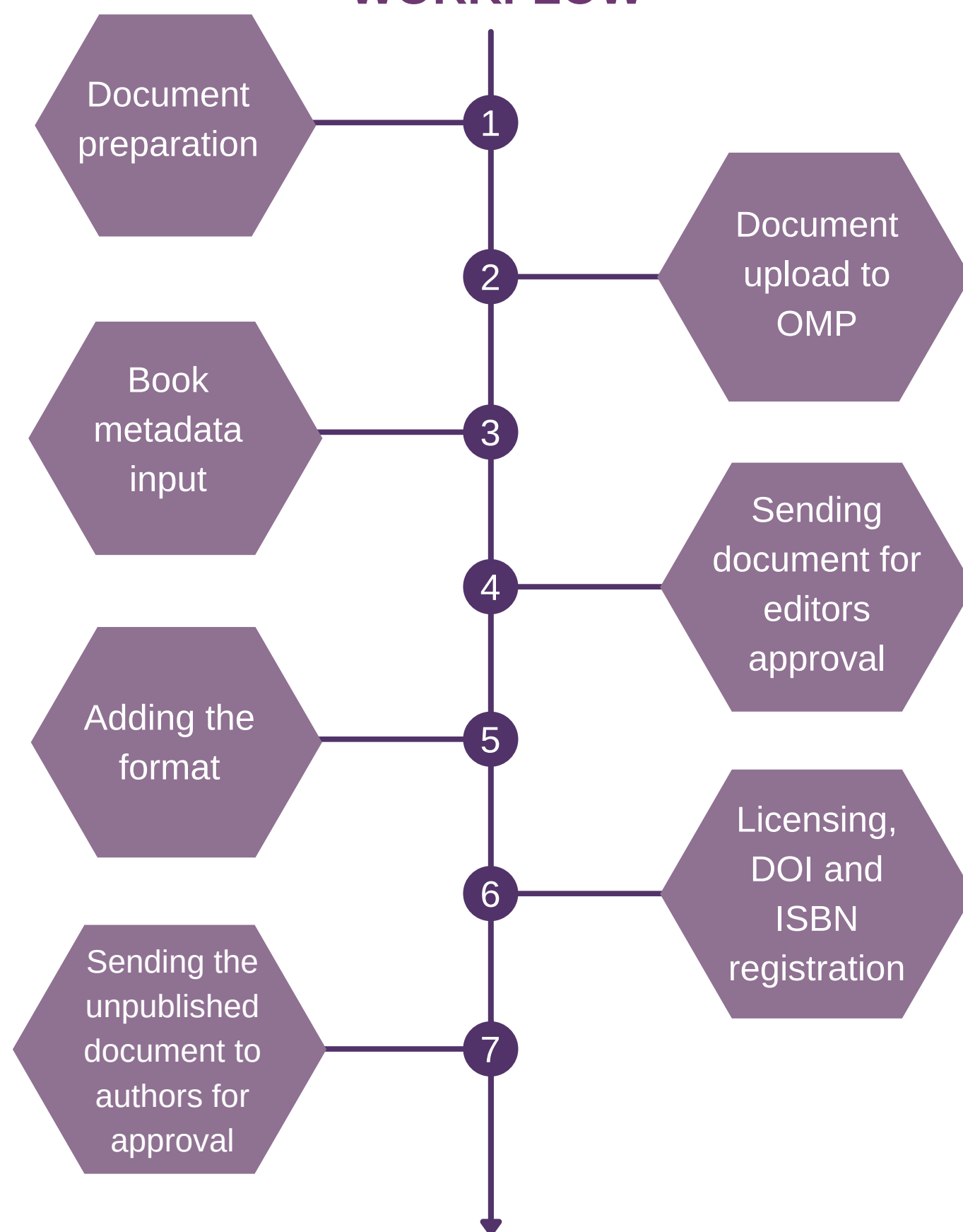
Open Press is a result of cooperation of a few services of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences: Faculty Library, FF Press and IT department.

The role of a librarian includes:

- taking care of the platform
- support for authors in all matters related to digital publication, availability, copyright and licenses
- creation and publication of digital editions - creation of metadata, promotion of visibility, registration of DOI marks.

The editorial team of the Faculty Library consists of Iva Melinščak Zlodi (also the project coordinator), Boris Čičovački, Lucija Klanac, Petra Kos, Irena Kranjec, Ivana Kukić, Željka Salopek, Katarina Starčević and Igor Vujanić.

MONOGRAPH INPUT WORKFLOW



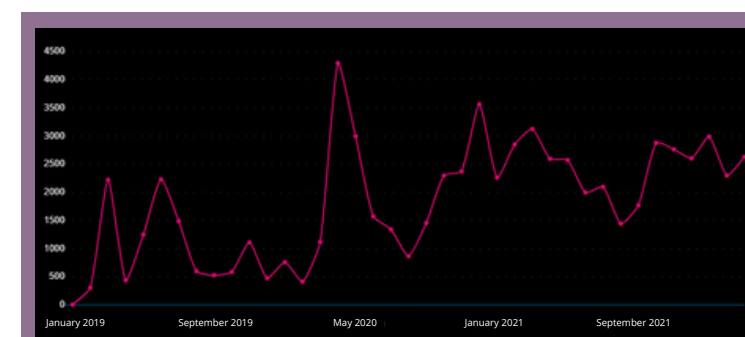
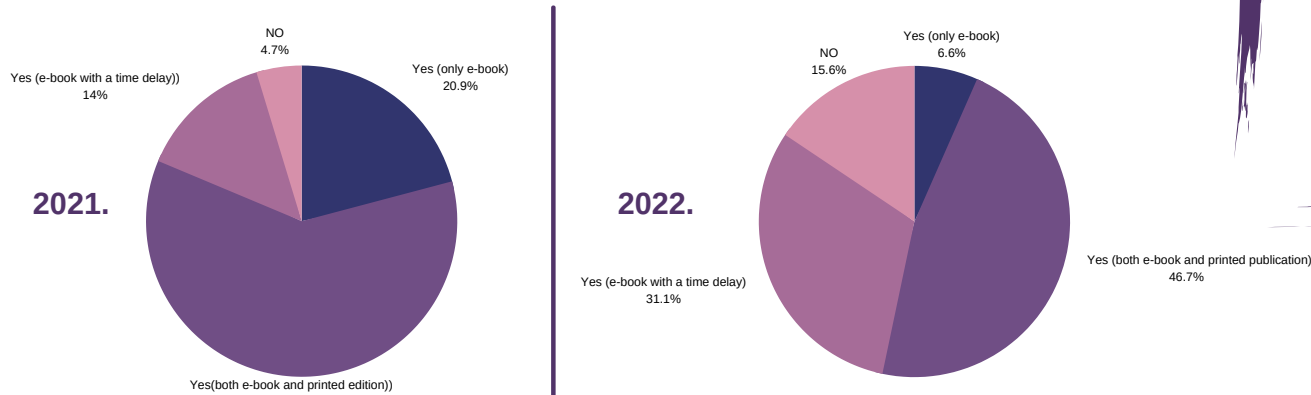
COPYRIGHT AND USAGE RIGHTS

Books in the FF Open Press are published under the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives 4.0 International License (CC BY-NC-ND 4.0) that permits the use, copying and redistribution of the material in any medium or format, but only for non-commercial purposes. The user must give appropriate credit, provide a link to the license, and indicate if changes were made. The license does not allow the distribution of modified (remixed, transformed, or built upon) works. Authors of the FF Open Press e-books are encouraged to deposit them in the repositories (subject or institutional), share them via social networks and distribute them in other ways to ensure their visibility and impact, but should always provide a link to the original publication in FF Open Press (preferably using the DOI persistent link).

OPEN ACCESS

Books are published in open access, providing users with "unrestricted, free, and undisturbed online access to digital scientific information that allows scientific information to be read, stored, distributed, searched, reached, indexed and/or used in any other legal way" in accordance with the Croatian Declaration on Open Access.

Since the beginning of the Open Press platform, the interest of authors in publishing on the platform has increased, as well as the interest of users in electronic editions - the importance of publishing in open access has been recognized due to the easier dissemination of scientific information.

The further plan is to increase attendance and activity on the platform and the availability of as many publications as possible through the joint engagement of librarians and authors and to regularly promote the platform by raising awareness about it in the academic community and through social networks (FB&IG) in the form of regular weekly announcements named Open Tuesday.
